Sampling Greens for Nematodes

- 1. Use a ¾-inch sampling probe (not a cup cutter).
- 2. Sample from the damaged areas. Take 12 to14 cores per green.
- 3. Sample 2-3 inches deep.
- 4. Combine plugs into a single bulk sample for each green.
- 5. Seal plugs from a single green in a one-quart "Zip-loc" plastic bag.
- 6. Use a permanent marker to label the bag with golf course name and green number.
- 7. Protect the bag from direct sunlight and heat.
- 8. Do not refrigerate or add water.
- 9. Include your business card or other identification in the shipping container.
- 10. Send sample to the diagnostic lab by overnight service
